## **Eligibility Criteria**

- 1) Willingness to participate in the ICC enquiry proceedings that may be conducted in the College (including Saturdays).
- 2) Should not be subjected to any disciplinary action and should not have any criminal records.
- 3) No backlog of papers for any semesters
- 4) Should have secured minimum 75% attendance in all semesters
- 5) Should submit a letter of recommendation from the Tutor and Head of The concerned Department.

#### **General Guidelines for Candidates**

- 1) Nomination papers and format of recommendation letter will be available in the college website.
- 2) Candidates should ensure that they fill the nomination form carefully. Any mistake in the nomination form will lead to rejection during scrutiny
- 3) Valid College ID card is mandatory for casting votes.
- 4) Mobile phone and smart watches are strictly prohibited inside the polling booth
- 5) Voting is to be made by writing the name of the candidate in the ballot paper provided.
- 6) Any other ambiguous markings made on the ballot paper will make the vote invalid.
- 7) No classes shall be disturbed for campaigning
- 8) Campaigning in the college premises should end one day before the conduct of election.
- 9) Pasting posters and writing campaigning slogans on the wall are prohibited.
- 10) Candidates/campaigners should strictly \ c refrain from making any personal or defamatory comments, abusive languages, etc. against other candidates or any individuals
- 11) Ant violation of the above-mentioned guidelines will invite cancellation of the candidature by the Returning Officer.
