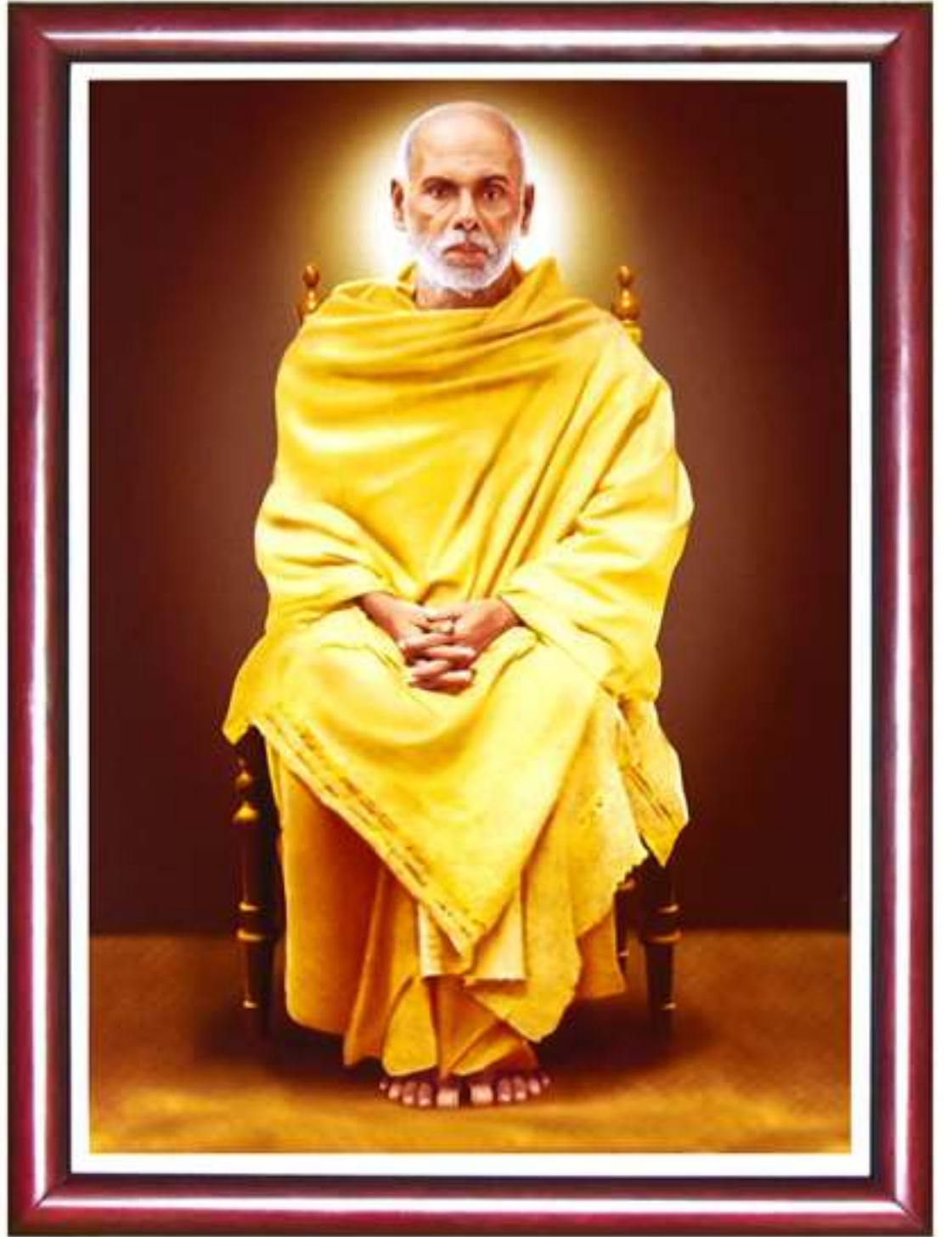

## **Report on the functioning of Sree Narayana College during 2022-23.**

The academic year 2022-23 at Sree Narayana College, Chempazhanthy commenced on 1st June 2022 with a council meeting outlining the plan of action for the year. The college witnessed a dynamic year with a focus on academic excellence, research, and active participation in extracurricular activities.

The college boasted a dedicated team of 66 permanent teaching staff and 13 contract lecturers during the academic year. 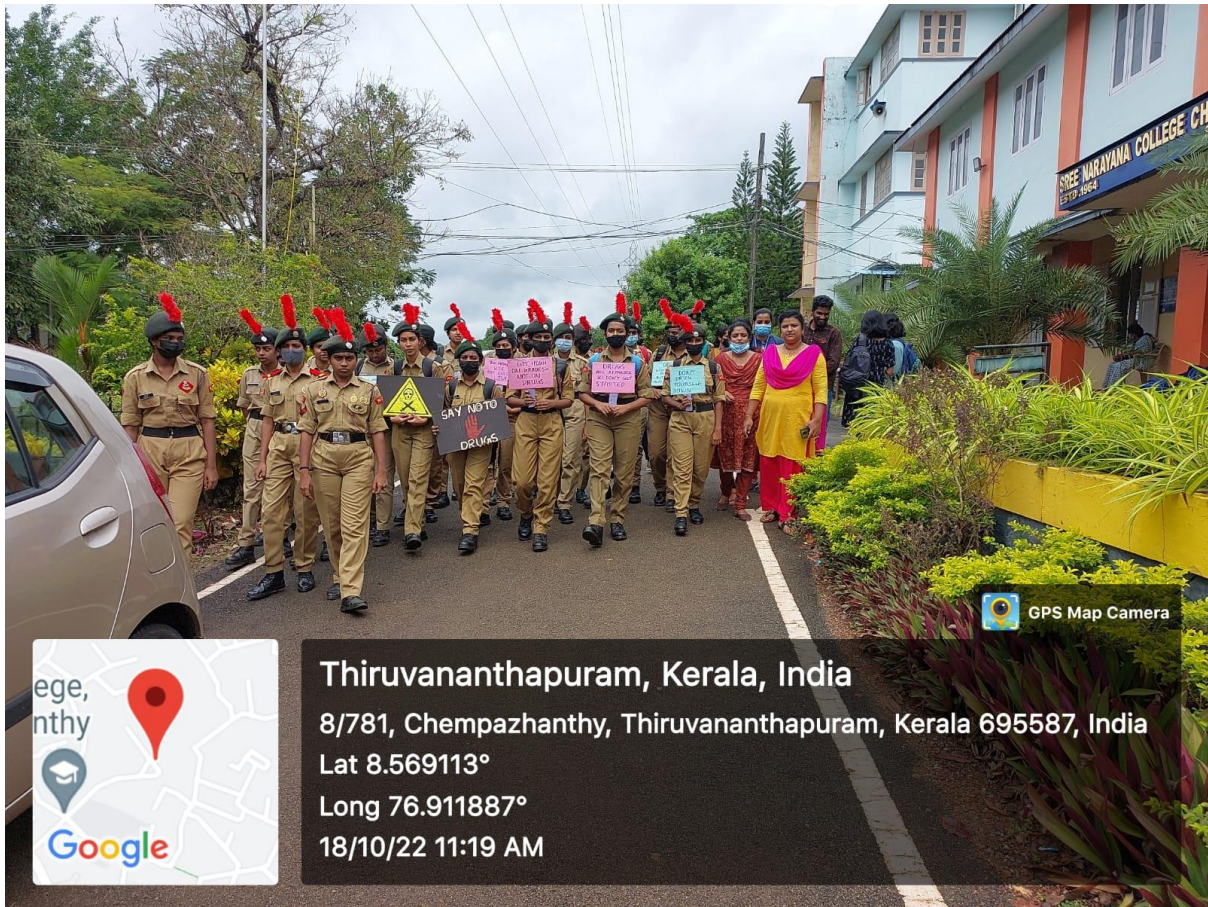
